RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING RE: PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION REGIONAL OFFICE IV LOCATED AT 139 PANAY AVENUE, BRGY. SOUTH TRIANGLE, QUEZON CITY

BAC Resolution No. 2020-09-001

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission Regional Office IV initially posted the Invitation to Bid for the project cited above in the PhilGEPS website, CSC RO IV website, and CSC RO IV Procurement Bulletin Board on June 30, 2020;

WHEREAS, three Supplemental Bid Bulletins were also posted on July 29, 2020, August 6, 2020, and August 25, 2020, respectively, in connection with the new schedule of the bidding activities, due to the sudden implementation of the modified enhanced community quarantine within the National Capital Region from August 4-18, 2020;

WHEREAS, on the scheduled submission and Bid Opening last September 1, 2020, only one (1) bidder responded to the posted invitation, namely the Baguio Investigation and Security Agency Inc;

WHEREAS, during the preliminary examination of bids, the BAC opened the first envelope of the bidder to check the submitted documents using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion, and was found and rated “failed” on the Item A.2 of the Eligibility Requirements;

WHEREAS, said Item on the Checklist of Eligibility, Technical and Financial Requirements contained in the Bidding Documents, states that the Tax Clearance issued by the BIR should be updated as of May 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Tax Clearance contained in the envelope was only as of September 17, 2019, hence, the “failed” rating on Item A.2 of the Eligibility Requirements;

WHEREAS, in Section 35.1.c. Failure of Bidding, the BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when all bids fail to comply with all the bid requirements;

WHEREAS, right after the bid opening on September 1, 2020, the BAC already conducted the mandatory review conference in cases of failed public bidding, pursuant to Section 35.2 of the 2016 IRR of R.A. No. 9184, which states that “in order to determine the reason for the failed bidding, the BAC shall conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including its cost estimates.”
